

2020 Superintendent Evaluation – Brad Gudme

The Memphis Community Schools Board of Education completed a comprehensive evaluation of Superintendent Brad Gudme on Monday, November 23, 2020, and continued on Monday, December 14, 2020 using an evaluation system provided by the Michigan Association of School Boards (MASB). The Board rated Mr. Gudme's effectiveness on 36 indicators using evidence from the 2020 calendar year. Mr. Gudme earned an overall rating of effective. This rating would not be possible without support from the dedicated, talented, and experienced District staff.

The Board of Education and the Administration are launching a new initiative to guide Memphis Community Schools through a 3-5 year strategic plan. Progress made on the District goals resulting from this effort along with other expectations highlighted by the Board will be a focus for Mr. Gudme in 2021. During the December 14th, 2020 meeting the Board acted to approve the 2020 evaluation with an effective rating with a vote of 6-1, with one abstention.
