***St. Clair County Health Department Offering Walk-in Flu Clinics  
September 4 Through November 13***

Starting September 4 through November 13, walk-in flu vaccination clinics will be available, while supplies last, Mondays from 10:00am - 6:00pm and Wednesdays 8:00am - 4:00pm at the St. Clair County Health Department main office located at 3415 28<sup>th</sup> Street in Port Huron. Appointments are Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Flu vaccines will also be available by appointment Monday through Friday at our Teen Health Center, for ages 10-21, located at 2215 Court Street in Port Huron (on the campus of Port Huron High School).

The Health Department will have a variety of flu vaccines to meet everyone's needs. For the best protection, those 6 months of age and older should receive a flu vaccine every year.

For those uninsured or underinsured, cost will vary based on income eligibility and family size. Most insurance is accepted and consider flu vaccination a covered benefit.
