Health Department Offering FREE Vision & Hearing Screening

The St. Clair County Health Department is offering free screening for any child entering preschool or kindergarten in the fall. Don't delay and have your child screened before school starts! Appointments are available and walk-ins will be accepted. Screening is offered at the St. Clair County Health Department located at 3415 28th Street, in Port Huron.

Screening Schedule:
August 21 – September 1
Mondays: 10:00am – 2:00pm and 3:00pm – 6:00pm
Tuesday through Friday 8:00am – 12:00pm and 1:00pm – 4:00pm

Why should you get your child screened?

- All children must have a hearing and vision screen before entering kindergarten.
- Screening can help your child succeed in school. An undiagnosed hearing and vision problem can interfere with your child's development.
- St. Clair County Health Department under the direction of The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services is committed to providing children with hearing and vision screens to ensure they have the skills necessary to succeed in school and learning.
- Early diagnosis and treatment can help prevent temporary difficulties from becoming permanent problems.
