The Memphis High School Alumni Association is not only to provide an enjoyable reunion every five years for our graduates, but also to continue to provide a scholarship to a graduating senior of MHS each year. This has been accomplished for the past 30 years. In 2006 our scholarship investment monies were turned over to the St. Clair County Community Foundation to be kept in perpetuity. This will provide a base for future scholarships that can be financed by the interest earned from the endowed funds.

Scholarship recipients are generally required to have attended Memphis High School for four years, earned at least a "C" average, to have participated in extra-curricular activities, be of good character, and admitted by a credible establishment of higher education.
